



Ticks and Lyme disease- Risk assessment checklist

- 1. Ticks are present across the UK in parks and woodland, fields and hills.
- 2. Ensure all adults on the trip read the tick bite prevention and removal information on the Lyme Resource Centre website or leaflets.
- 3. If the children will be outdoors ask the parents to: pack appropriate insect repellent ensure long sleeves are worn and trousers and do a thorough tick check when home and shower.
- 4. Ensure that your first aid kit contains at least one tick removal tool eg a tick removal card or tick twister.
- 5. Advise children to tell an adult immediately if they spot an attached tick not to attempt to remove it themselves.
- 6. If a child does get bitten ensure the tick is removed using the **correct technique** as soon as possible. Send a letter to inform the parents.
